#### **Context**



 For any digital transformation to take off, broadband connectivity is a requisite.

 Africa still lags behind in terms of availability and affordability of broadband Internet access.

For broadband wireless connectivity to be a reality in Africa,
 the right policies and regulations need to be in place first.



#### What is PRIDA

The "Policy and Regulation Initiative for Digital Africa" (PRIDA) is an ongoing joint initiative of the African Union (AU), the European Union (EU) and the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).

PRIDA's overall objective is to foster universally accessible and affordable broadband across the continent to unlock future benefits of internet based services.

#### What is PRIDA T1

The specific objective is to create a more harmonised and enabling legal and regulatory framework for the use of ICT for social and economic development, with an emphasis on boosting the spectrum market across Africa.

PRIDA fosters harmonization efforts at Pan-African level of the four core functions:

- spectrum licensing
- spectrum pricing
- spectrum refarming
- cross border frequency coordination





#### What is PRIDA T1

### PRIDA T1 contains 26 Actions grouped in 5 outputs:



- Output 1: Spectrum allocation based on international best practices is improved: harmonizing spectrum utilization in Africa, particularly spectrum utilization for wireless broadband access.
- Output 2: Terms and conditions for spectrum licensing are improved as well as spectrum pricing predictability and alignment on international best practice.
- Output 3: Cooperation related to the treatment of harmful interference is strengthened via cross-border frequency coordination agreements.
- Output 4: Awareness and acceptance of the concept and economic models of Internet of Things (IoT) is increased.
- Output 5: Capacity building. Train the staff of national regulatory agencies.



### Work Programme, T1



- 1. Analysis of the current legislative and regulatory framework and the usage of spectrum as of today as well as in the foreseeable future
- 2. Developing Guidelines on radio frequency regulation based on ITU Radio Regulations, ITU-R Recommendations, Reports and Handbooks, regional harmonization frameworks, case studies, country experiences and regional consultations.
- 3. Developing Guidelines for national radio frequency spectrum coordination including refarming methods.
- 4. Collect information on the availability of the backhaul links (incl. fiber).
- 5. Based on the Guidelines above propose improvements of national radio spectrum regulations.
- 6. Based on the Guidelines above propose harmonized refarming plans for the usage of frequency bands identified for wireless broadband.
- 7. Based on the Guidelines above propose roadmap and priorities for wireless broadband deployment in Africa.
- 8. Providing technical assistance for national spectrum entities to transpose these roadmaps.
- 9. Preparing Guidelines for radio frequency spectrum licensing for wireless broadband
- 10. Preparing Guidelines for pricing
- 11. Preparing Guidelines for usage
- 12. Preparing Guidelines for HCM4A
- 13. Assessing the HCM4A agreement for sub-Saharan Africa and make assessment on current cross border frequency coordination agreements
- 14. Updating the number of countries interested in implementation of the HCM4A
- 15. Updating HCM4A agreement taking into account the results of the assessments and the updated version of the HCM Europe
- 16. Organizing workshops to validate the updated cross border frequency coordination agreement and developing the HCM4A software
- 17. Providing support to the implementation of the updated HCM4A agreement and the software in Sub Sahara Africa and to North Africa
- 18. On request assisting countries in specific cases for cross border frequency coordination and providing technical assistance for the resolution of critical situation
- 19. Providing policy outreach on concept and business models of IoT.
- 20. Providing overview on the ITU activities and ensuring participation in relevant ITU meetings.
- 21. Developing guidelines and associated case studies regarding type approval regulations
- 22. Developing guidelines and associated case studies regarding EMF and EMC for IoT
- 23. Organizing workshops on digital technologies and relevant frequency issues in relation to IoT.
- 24. Organizing capacity building workshops.
- 25. Organizing a 5G annual African Continental Conference -PRIDA focus-
- 26. Provide direct technical assistance to countries (on demand), on: a) The transposal of our Guidelines for pricing; b) Digital Migration; c) Implementation of modern spectrum management regulatory framework; d) Updating national allocation tables; e) Others (as requested by countries)

### **PRIDA T1 Guidelines and Roadmaps**

- Continental and regional guidelines with associated case studies created through a consultative process with relevant continental, regional and national focal points and stakeholders.
- Regional harmonized roadmaps for the adaptation of the current legislative and regulatory framework.
- The Guidelines and Roadmaps will serve as references to develop policy and regulation related to:
  - Technology and standards policies, licensing regimes, frequency management;
  - Consumer aspects and business planning;
  - Harmonization of the utilization of the Digital Dividend taking into account the relevant outputs of the ITU-R and the ITU-D;
  - Cross-border frequency coordination
- Guidelines and roadmaps' adoption/endorsement: the validated draft Guidelines and Roadmaps will be transferred to the Regional Economic Communities/Regional Organizations (RECs/ROs) for consideration.
- National transposition of regional Guidelines
  - Technical direct assistance to requesting beneficiary countries in transposing them at the national level.
  - It will depend on the specific situation of each country to ensure compliance with existing national legislation.













