
Agility/Flexibility - consumption of solution

workload

Commercial –



- > Consumable as a service
- > Hyper-scalable
- > Sustainable
- > SLAs -
 - 100% Uptime

Community –

- Hosted by member
- Limited scalability
- ➤ Not sustainable (budget cycle)
- > SLAs -
 - Resource availability

On premise -



- > Resource management
- > Lack of interoperability
- Continuous renewal
- > SLAs -
 - Maintenance downtimes





Cybersecurity, data sovereignty and protection

Commercial cloud platforms –

- Extensive opportunities for threat surveillance (SOCS)
- Compliant regarding the use of personal data (GDPR)
- ➤ Meet global information community standards (ISO2701)
- Penalties
- Local data centres/resellers

- > 50 Service Providers connected






NREN – What's our role (consumables)?

✓ Provide national bandwidth Networks –

- ✓ Regional collaboration
- ✓ Global connectivity

Above the Net –

- ➤ Catalogue of cloud and Digital Services
- ➤ Develop relationships with market in-country
- ➤ Provide access to call-off agreements
- ➤ Support local cloud forums
- ➤ Procure on behalf of R&E community (underwriter/Buyer Group)
- Evangelize services via webinars and conferences
- ➤ Host agreed upon supplier engagements
- Communicate funding calls for institutes
- ➤ Provide support for local buyer groups







GEANT cloud framework

Pan-European tender - Infrastructure as a Service (IaaS)







- 36 participating NRENs through GÉANT
- Using EC Procurement Directive (2014/24/EU)
- 10 000 R&E institutions as a Single Digital Market
- 11 different laaS solutions
- 21 providers, incl. Amazon & Microsoft resellers
- Open procurementnot winner takes all
- 4 year framework agreements



Ambitions

Europe is the largest producer of research data in the world.

The EC wants to increase the use of this data and interconnect research IT infrastructures through the European Open Science Cloud.

OCRE intends to –

- 1. Provide researchers with access to commercial cloud and digital services.
- 2. Drive the adoption of such services and stimulate the European digital economy.



- Promote agility in local research activities (harness analytics platforms; machine learning; AI)
- Support collaboration (both regional and global)
- Drive broader EOSC ambitions (OPEN research; FAIR data; stimulation of SME development;
 sustainability)
- Stimulate European digital economy
 - Grow emerging earth observation digital solutions (DIAS)
- Provide for acquisition and service discovery (onboard onto EOSC-hub)

OCRE project – key points

European research - adoption of digital services in support of innovation and agility

Procurement

- Easy to use pan-European procurement frameworks
 - ➤ laaS; PaaS; SaaS (as platform and software relates to infrastructure)
 - > Platform solutions for Earth Observation consuming Copernicus data
- European providers of digital services
 - > Local suppliers of platform in each country
 - > Extended local services in support of platform
 - > Data located in Europe on GDPR compliant, standardized hosting
 - ➤ Providers include a limited number of local resellers of global hyperscale platforms facilitating short-term compute at scale services and bursting as demand for capacity spikes


Adoption funding

- Early adoption by researcher (Wave 1)–
 - Cloud vouchers procured from providers on the existing GEANT laaS framework
 - > 2nd part vouchers to be procured from suppliers on new OCRE frameworks (incl EO) = 2020
- o Institutional project support (Wave 2) will procure services via OCRE frameworks
- Buyer group project co-funding will provide for the 50% sponsorship for digital services for approved projects






OCRE in a nutshell
